- Cost of entry is \$40 PER MAN. No entries will be accepted without full payment of \$120 for the team.
- A competitor may only enter once.
- The members of the first place team will receive trophy belt buckles.
- Cash prizes will be awarded, based on the amount of entries received. Please consult the rules page for details.
- Entries will be limited. Once the event is full, no more entries will be taken.
- NO phone entries will be taken. Pre-entries are to be postmarked by May 21st, or entries will be taken on site from 12:30pm to 2:30pm at the secretary's table.
- Only trucks from teams that are PRE-ENTERED will be allowed to be parked inside the gate. A parking pass will be assigned to you, allowing entry. No one without a parking pass will be allowed to bring in a vehicle.
- The woodcutting will begin no earlier than 3pm.
- After drawing decks, teams may begin to prepare their decks prior to the event.

- ALL contestants must sign a release of liability.
- All returned checks will be electronically debited for the face value, plus a \$25 fee.

Awards and Prize Money

- ◇ Each man on the first place team will be awarded a trophy belt buckle.
- ◇ Prize money will be determined by the number of teams entered in the pot.
 - With 2 teams competing, first place pays \$80 per man.
 - With 3 teams competing, first place pays \$80 per man and second place pays \$40 per man.
 - With 4 teams competing, first place pays \$100 per man and second place pays \$60 per man.
 - With 5 or more teams competing, first place pays \$100 per man, second place pays \$60 per man, and third place pays \$40 per man.
 - With 6 or more teams competing, first place pays \$100 per man, second place pays \$80 per man, and third place pays \$60 per man.

Event Rules

1. Participants must be eighteen (18) years old or older in order to compete.
2. Teams will consist of three (3) people.
3. There will be a maximum of eight (8) teams allowed to complete.
4. Lots will be drawn and teams will be run in heats.
5. Teams will have twelve (12) minutes to saw, split, and stack as much acceptable wood as possible.
6. Only stacked wood pieces will be counted.
7. The stack must reach the top of the wire before starting a new row.
8. Each team may have two (2) saws with only one (1) running at any time.
9. Each team may have two (2) mauls. No back up mauls will be allowed.
10. Wood lengths must be fifteen inches (15") minimum in order to count.
11. Wood widths may be no smaller than three and a half inches (3 ½") and no greater than nine inches. (9").
12. All judges' decisions will be final.
